ACCOMPANYING PERSON PROGRAM

Visit: Bela Vista Biological Refuge

Bus depart: 8:00 AM – Bourbon Cataratas

Duration: Approximately 2 hours and 30 minutes, including about 30 minutes by bus and 2 hours of light walking.

Lunch: 11:30 AM

Return to the hotel: 1:00 PM

Description: The tour is divided into two parts. In the first part, participants travel in a special tour vehicle from the Visitor Reception Center to the Bela Vista Biological Refuge. The route passes through the Binational Security Area Control Barrier of ITAIPU and along the shores of the Piracema Park's resting lake. This leg of the journey offers views of reforested areas, zones reserved for ITAIPU Transmission Towers, and the back of the ITAIPU C Neighborhood.

The second part of the tour is conducted on foot, covering approximately 2 kilometers. Visitors will have the opportunity to plant a native tree, visit the small port at the refuge along the ITAIPU lake, and explore the Zoo, which houses more than 15 animal enclosures.

Tuesday, 20

Visit: Bird Park

Bus depart: 9:00 AM

Duration: Approximately 2 hours of light walking.

Lunch: 11:30 AM

Return to the hotel: 1:30 PM

Description: At Parque das Aves, the tour is self-guided along a U-shaped trail approximately 1,600 meters long. During the walk, you will pass through 5 immersion aviaries, where you can observe the birds up close (but without touching them). Environmental educators are available along the route to assist and answer your questions, ensuring an informative and engaging experience.

Lunch: 12h (Churrascaria Ponto Certo)

Thursday, 22

Visit: City tour (with a visit to a Arab Mosque) and shopping

Bus depart: 8:30 AM

Duration: Approximately 2 hours.

Lunch: 12:00 AM

Return to the hotel: 1:00 PM

Description: This visit features unique and distinct locations, perfect for capturing beautiful photos and learning about the history of Foz do Iguaçu. The tour begins with a panoramic view of the Omar Ibn Al-Khatab Mosque, a Muslim place of worship., and includes a stop at the Kapadokya store, both representing one of the largest Arab communities in Brazil. With over 12,000 immigrants, Foz do Iguaçu hosts the country's second-largest Arab community, after São Paulo.

The next stop is the stunning Buddhist Temple, showcasing brilliant and richly detailed statues and replicas of Mi La Pu-San, the famous seated Buddha. The serene religious atmosphere makes it an ideal spot for meditation.

Following this, we visit the Cathedral of Our Lady of Guadalupe, where you can immerse yourself in the meanings of Christianity. Located at the city's highest point, reminiscent of a Biblical hill, this site offers a significant spiritual experience.

The tour concludes with a panoramic drive along the city's main avenues, including Avenida Brasil, ending with a shopping session at the local mall.

Lunch: 12h

General instructions: Given the typical climate of Foz do Iguaçu, where temperatures can range from **20 to 30°C** with high humidity, visitors should **wear light, breathable clothing and comfortable walking shoes**. It is also advisable to **bring a raincoat or umbrella**, as sudden rain showers are common. Don't forget to **bring a camera** for the wonderful photo opportunities and to apply sunscreen and **insect repellent** to ensure a comfortable visit.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

On Thursday, 22, when visiting the mosque, appropriate attire is mandatory. Visitors must remove their shoes before entering and keep their voices low. Please wait until prayers have concluded before entering the temple. Women are required to wear a veil, which will be provided by the organizer.
